Dear Parents and Carers of KS2 children,

I am confident that you know the children are at the centre of everything we do. I therefore write to you regarding our preparations for any potential remote learning. Please do not be alarmed, it is <u>not</u> happening now – we will write to you to inform you if there is a partial or full closure of school, as per Department of Education guidance.

We are preparing for this because we want to ensure the highest quality teaching and learning continues, even if children are not in class at school with their teacher. If the time comes where we have to engage in remote learning, KS2 teachers will stream English and Maths lessons live and provide other learning for other subjects (including pre-recorded teaching videos) online via Microsoft Teams.

We have created an email address and login for each KS2 pupil for Microsoft Teams – software which allows children and teachers to stream live lessons and exchange work files online. Your child's login details will be written down in their Reading Diary. Attached to this letter is a **KS2 Remote Learning**Information Booklet. It tells you:

- 3. What we are doing in school.
- 4. What you can do to support your child with Microsoft Teams.
