The clubs will **not** be extra-curricular clubs unfortunately, as we do not have the staff or space to do this during these challenging times. We will only be able to offer childcare until you finish work/up to 3:45pm. Children who qualify for this childcare will stay in their classrooms and have a chance to, for example, read for pleasure, finish their homework, take part in activities such as 'colour yourself calm' to promote their wellbeing until they are collected. If you finish earlier (than 3:45pm), we would expect that you collect your child at that earlier time.
