

Miss Potter's Bird Feeder Challenge.

Have you noticed that the birds are making their nests so why not help them out by making a BIRD FEEDER?

- You can use an orange to put the seed in.



Scoop out the orange and eat it...YUM! (Ask a parent to help you with this.)

Then fill with seed or nuts and hang it up in a tree or put it on wall.

- If you don't have any bird food you can thread cereal onto a piece of string, wire or pipe cleaner.

Be creative and make the bird feeder into different shapes!





- **Make a tin can feeder.**
Wash out the can and then decorate it. You could use anything such as paints, pens or ribbons. This can has had a stick glued into the bottom so the birds can perch on it. Hang it up with ribbon, string or wool.

- **Make a Lego Bird feeder.**
If you have some Lego you can make a bird feeding station. Make sure that you press the Lego bricks together firmly.



- **Use an apple to feed the birds.**
Simply get an apple and push sticks into it so the birds have a place to perch. If you want you could also push some seeds into the apple for an extra tasty treat!



- **Make a bottle bird feeder.**
You could use an old milk bottle, water bottle or pop bottle.
Wash the bottle out.
Carefully cut a hole in the side...
You might need your parents to help you!
Then decorate the bottle with pens and felt tips.



Then wait and watch for the birds to come.
