Stick Tower Challenge

Challenge a member of your family to see who can make the tallest stick tower.





Think about your design!




If you can't find any sticks try using crayons/pencils or felt tips.

Make a Stick Picture Frame Challenge

Tie the corners with string or wool.

You could use a square lashing... Look at Miss Potter's Knot Challenges on the side bar to learn how to do this!



You can also secure the corners with tape.


Make a Beautiful Weaving Challenge



Use your stick picture frame to make a weaving...

Simply weave different coloured wool and string around the frame in different directions.

Remember when you weave you go under then over the different threads.



Make a Stick Character Challenge



Secure some stick arms with string, wool or tape.

Make a head... you could use a pompom, plasticine, blue tack or draw a face on some paper or card.

Use what you have at home to dress your stick character.

You could use tissue, material, paper, wool or even make a costume from leaves.





Make a Stick Shelter Challenge

If you have some garden poles you could use them to make a cosy shelter. Ask for your parents' permission first.



If you haven't got any rope or string you can attach the poles using tape.

If you have got rope or string you could use a square lashing ... Take a look at Miss Potter's Knot Challenges to help you!



Make a Stick Sundial Challenge





Find a stick and secure it on the ground (I used Blue Tack) in a sunny spot.

Mark the shadow on the floor with some chalk and record the time.
